

Medicare has rules that apply to rebates for thyroid ultrasound examinations. Medicare will only provide a rebate when the request form specifically includes one of the following suspected pathologies:

Item	Description
55032	Thyroid Ultrasound
	Where the service is provided, for the assessment of one or more of the following conditions or suspected conditions:
	a. Evaluation of palpable thyroid nodule or mass
	<ul> <li>Evaluation of abnormalities detected on other imaging regarding thyroid, parathyroid or neck masses</li> </ul>
	c. Follow up known thyroid nodule
	d. Evaluation of presence, size and location of thyroid
	e. Screening of high-risk patients for occult thyroid malignancy
	f. Localisation of Parathyroids in patients with hyperparathyroidism
	g. Staging of thyroid cancer-Surveillance for recurrent disease for a patient with a history of thyroid cancer
	h. Ultrasound guided FNAB of thyroid lymph node or neck
	Benefits are not payable when referred for:
	Abnormal thyroid function test
	Abnormal thyroid antibodies
	<ul> <li>Symptoms such as sore throat, neck pain and globus pharyngeus-type symptoms</li> </ul>
