

Endometriosis Ultrasound Imaging Requests

Medicare has rules that apply to rebates for endometriosis ultrasound examinations. Medicare will only provide a rebate when the request form specifically includes one of the following suspected pathologies:

Item	Description
55080	<p>Pelvis Ultrasound Scan of the pelvis, by any or all approaches (including transvaginal), if:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">a) the patient is known to have, or the requesting practitioner suspects, a complex gynaecological condition; andb) the service is considered a complex investigation requiring a minimum of 30 minutes scanning time. <p><i>This item covers the use of ultrasound scans for the assessment, management or planning, of a patient suspected of or diagnosed with a complex gynaecological condition which includes, but is not limited to, a range of complex gynaecological conditions such as endometriosis, adenomyosis, pelvic congestion syndrome, chronic pelvic inflammatory disease, and pelvic floor dysfunction. The requesting practitioner must have identified that the patient is suspected of having, or is known to have a complex gynaecological condition</i></p>
